Join a dynamic team at Arkansas Children's of three faculty members, APPs, a dietitian, social worker, pharmacist, transplant coordinators, child life specialist and specialty nurses for clinic-related activities as well as research nursing support and transplant infectious disease physicians, providing nationally ranked and recognized care to patients statewide and regionally. - Full-time position, with a minimum of 20% protected research/academic time devoted to research efforts and scholarly pursuits, with the possibility of up to 80% protected research/academic time for those with funding/support

- UAMS pediatric hematology oncology fellowship training program
- Actively engaged in national research initiatives through COG, PTCTC, Pediatric Real World CAR Consortium, POETIC, NACHO, Beat Childhood Cancer Research Consortium and industry-supported clinical trials
- Ideal candidates will have strong clinical skills and experience in treating patients with malignant diseases, including the use of autologous and allogeneic BMT as well as CAR-T therapy in both inpatient and outpatient settings
- Applicants must have the ability and desire to collaborate as a member of a growing team and align with the needs of the program. A demonstrated interest in clinical and/or translational research is preferred
